Footnotes

WINDING ROAD was five wide on the first turn then assumed command on the run down the backstretch, was in a strong drive in the stretch and held way in the final stride. OLD CHUNK OF COAL vied for the early lead from the inside, then stalked the leader from the inside on the backstretch, rallied two wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground strongly but just missed in the end. HOLLY JET was unhurried early and settled, started a run on the far turn while inside then swung out to be eight wide in mid stretch for clear running room and closed fast on the outside but was too late. CACHEMASSA CREEK was unhurried early then rallied and moved out to be six wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground in late stretch but hung in the end. CURRAGH MON was allowed to settle while inside, moved out to be three wide for the stretch drive and was no threat in the end. COOK'S NOOK was allowed to settle then rallied three wide on the far turn, made a bid but flattened out in the stretch drive. KELEVRA was unhurried early then raced two wide on the far turn and was no menace in the stretch drive. SAN GIMIGNANO vied for the early lead while three wide then was used up and gave way in the stretch. MACEDONIAN was unhurried early then raced six wide to upper stretch and was no threat. THE TAP vied for the early lead while four wide, was used up

and gave way. MAGESTIC WILDCAT chased the early pace while four wide then moved to the inside, was used up and inside on the far turn then stopped. WINGO (IRE) was far back and trailed throughout.
