WAR HYMN chased the early pace then rallied three wide on the turn, was in a long sustained drive while inside in the stretch, dug in gamely throughout late stretch and prevailed in the end. PRECOCIOUS ZAK was allowed to settle then rallied on the turn while four wide, was in a long sustained drive in the stretch on the outside but hung in late stretch. CHIMES COUNTDOWN set the early pace then drew off on the turn then weakened in late stretch. WALTZ ACROSS TEXAS was inside on the run down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn making a bid then came up empty in the drive. M G WALTZ was unhurried early and was no threat. ALPHABET MAN pressed the early pace while racing two wide, was used up and stopped.
