MAVERICK PRINCE chased the early pace from the inside, moved up heading into the turn to dueled for the lead, was in a long drive throughout and drew off in late stretch and proved best. PROSPECT BREWING settled then was saving ground on the turn, rallied and was gaining ground in late stretch to finished well. HALIFAX FLYER was inside then blocked on the turn while three wide, got shuffled back then split rivals in upper stretch and closed like a rocket in late stretch to finished fastest of all. MASTER TIME set the early pace then dueled for the lead while two wide on the turn, was hard sued then weakened in the stretch drive. OTIS HILL was inside and saving ground on the turn, made a mild rally in the stretch but was no menace. JADA BO was well placed while racing three wide, made a bid in the middle of the turn to upper stretch then faltered in the drive. FLEETING ROAD was four wide on the turn then failed to menace in the stretch. LAURA'S BO BO was unhurried early while racing two wide and was no threat. THAT'S OUR ROMEO raced three wide into the turn, was used up and faltered. HARPAGE four wide into the turn and no factor. POWERED BY CAT chased the early pace while two wide, bore out on the turn then stopped. ZAP A PRINCE showed brief foot and stopped. VALID SPECTACLE was two wide and suddenly stumbled and fell entering the turn then got up and was vanned off. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the running of the race. After reviewing the films, no action was taken.
