WACO HUG was unhurried early then saved ground going into the far turn, swung out three wide at the top of the stretch and was in a strong drive to pull away in the end. SILVERBACK CAT set a well handled pace from the start, was in sustained drive in the stretch but tired in the end while clearly second best. BAY HERO chased the pace while inside and saving ground on the far turn then made a bid coming out of the far turn but was no threat in the stretch drive. WHIZVILLE chased the early pace while racing two wide, was in good striking position heading into the far turn but came up empty in the drive. BURBERRY BULLET was allowed to settled early while inside, moved out to be two wide on the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch. NO SMALL STAR was hustled along to pressed the pace while three wide on the first turn then was used up to stay in contention and gave way on the far turn. W. C. RUNAWAY was through early while inside and stopped. SYN RIVER was four wide on the first turn and was no threat throughout. MISTY was outrun. RUN FOR GOVENOR was through after a half.
