CLEAR STORM was settled early then rallied on the turn while three wide then was in a strong drive on the outside and powered to the front in late stretch to prove best. KELLY'S CLASS vied for the early lead while three wide then dueled for the lead in the stretch from the inside and dug in gamely but tired in late stretch. FOXY SECRET vied for the early lead while four wide then dueled on the outside in the stretch drive but hung in late stretch. OIL PATCH ANNIE settled early then rallied four wide at the top of the stretch and made a mild gain. DAWN AND AL'S GIRL was bumped at the start then raced five wide in the stretch and was no menace. SUGAR BABY DISCO raced six wide on the turn and failed to menace in the stretch. QUEEN OF ADKINS vied for the early lead while two wide, was used up and gave way in the stretch. TRIESTE EXPRESS vied for the lead while inside, was hard used and stopped in the stretch. HAVANA HARBOR was on the inside and no threat. TRI TO BELIEVE raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. TIME FOR MERN was on the inside and outrun. TEXAS WAR was bumped at the start then dropped back and showed little.
