ERRONEOUS TOO dueled early, got caught three wide in the turn, drew clear with a quarter mile left and moved inward by the start of the stretch run and won driving. COLTON COUNTDOWN chased the dueling leaders, advanced quickly to a rail position entering the turn, raced on willingly but was no match for the winner. CLASSOFSIXTYNINE settled well off the lead, steadily advanced but was five wide in the turn, long drive. THE RIGHT MOVES was bumped slightly at the start, was asked for run not long after, no threat. SENOR BUDDY raced along in midpack down the backstretch, drifted five wide in the turn, held third. WEGONE dueled for the early lead and was two wide entering the turn, drifted out four wide by the completion of the turn and had little left for the run down the stretch. JUSTIN TIME ABBIE was unable to keep up early and was no threat. RIO BISCUITS reared at the start, failed to reach contention, tired with quarter mile left. The race was hand timed.
