UNDER OATH was content to settle in midpack while racing along the rail in the first turn, was put under a drive nearing the three-eighths pole but had to advance five wide in the final turn and remained in that position the rest of the way for a game victory. EDGY MEMORIE broke outward at the start and raced up to be three wide in the opening turn, was three wide in the final turn and put away a rival with a quarter mile to go but veered outward slightly at the top of the lane and was no match for the winner's rally. THUNDER BRITCHES was three wide while in a stalking position in the opening turn, then advanced to be four wide in the final turn before failing to advance under constant urging in the stretch. KOOL SOLDIER stalked the leaders while two wide in the opening turn, picked up the pace nearing the five-eighths pole and raced along in contention while remaining two wide through the second turn, not tiring until after the quarter pole. FIEND A BIT unhurried early and three wide in the opening turn, remained wide down backstretch and had no rally. HASHA raced along the rail through the first turn, unhurried, no threat. SON OF THE WEST showed early speed and gained rail path in the first turn, remained along rail until the three-eighths pole and was done.
