DURRYMANE broke sharply then was settled behind the early lead to stalked that pair, moved to the outside three wide going into the far turn and rallied strongly to gain command coming out of the far turn, drew off in mid stretch then was kept to strong pressure to hold sway in late stretch. JENZ BENZ was settled on the run down the backstretch while racing three wide, rallied on the far turn and was four wide in the stretch and closed willingly in deep stretch to finish strong. BOUNDUS raced three wide on the first turn and backstretch then rallied on the far turn making a bid to mid stretch then came up empty in the drive. SPEED FEST was four wide on the first turn then was sent up to duel for the lead from the outside, drew off on the far turn then weakened in the stretch dive. FUNNY TUNE was settled in the early going and saved ground throughout, came out to split rivals in late stretch and closed willingly late but was no threat. ANNIE SAVOY raced two wide throughout and made a bid on the far turn but raced evenly in the stretch. MAGIC STREAK on the inside and saved ground, made a bid on the far turn but faltered in the stretch drive. DANCING DUDETE failed to menace. SENORA TORMENTA raced four wide on the far turn and failed to menace throughout. STAGE STOP was outrun and showed little. RAPID RIVER was outrun. SLEWPY'S STAR dueled for the early lead while inside, was used up and stopped on the far turn.
