Footnotes

SIMONESSA was sent to the front, remained outside of rivals down the backstretch, edged clear at the seven-sixteenths pole, was traveling easily when the rider peaked back to see the field at the quarter pole, was roused when entering the stretch and kept to task during the final eighth. RIVER RAPIDS dueled for the early lead, advanced after the top one while two wide in the turn, asked at the three-eighths pole yet no match for the winner. LOVELY JANDENISE pressured the leaders from the inside, had a rail trip till drifting three wide in the turn and tired. SHESASMOOCHEN was slow out of the gate and quickly asked to make it up, soon found a spot in midpack, had the spot on the rail in the turn and made a steady advance under urging through the stretch. SLEW OF BLOSSOMS was unhurried out of the gate, three wide in the turn, never in serious contention. HEAVENLY PATH was ridden along to chase the early leaders, could not keep up and was four wide in the turn and began to tire. STAR WAR showed little. ONTHEWAYHOME was eased back to middle of the pack and did little running after that.
