KIPLING'S RED BIRD dropped in three wide in the opening turn and kept under a tight hold, pulled the rider at the quarter pole, settled into a stride by the half mile, was roused at the quarter pole and was three wide, battled on in the final sixteenth and edged ahead. SURPRIZED WINNER settled early and kept the rail in the first turn, stalked down the backstretch, was two wide in the final turn, angled out to pass the tiring frontrunner at the eighth pole, led there, but could not hold on. PHARME'S MISSTEAK tugged and was three wide in the first turn, raced along to be four wide in the final turn and tired when the race was up for grabs in deep stretch. NEW DAWN FAWN was slow to start yet carried four wide in the first turn, raced along in that position down the back stretch and second turn and failed to menace. INERTIA was roused shortly after the start, yet five wide in the first turn and soon began to tire. ST. REGIS was hustled out of the gate, angled inward and was a clear leader while two wide in the opening turn, allowed to open a wide lead down the backstretch, was put to the task leaving the turn yet had enough by the eighth pole. GOLDENBULLETDAY settled in midpack, was three wide in the first turn and failed to content. GROWSONTREES content to settle behind the big margin of the early leader, two wide in the first turn while in the forward group of chasers, showed signs of tiring by the three-eighths pole and stopped badly soon after. WOODY'S QUEEN was slow to start and was not competitive.
