TAKSENT was settled while inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn then rallied and angled out to be three wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and powered to the front and proved best in the end. TEXAS TYCOON vied for the lead from between rivals, was in a long drive and gamely dug in but tired in deep stretch. MR. ROAD WARRIOR vied for the lead while three wide into the turn, was in a long sustained drive then weakened in late stretch. ROAD WORK was unhurried early then rallied along the inside in the stretch but was no menace. THE TAP was five wide on the turn and failed to menace in the stretch. LUCKY RAJA stalked the pace while racing four wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered. KELEVRA vied for the early lead while inside, was used up and gave way on the turn. BOTTOM TO TOP was two wide into the turn, was used up and faltered. IRISH CHIEF was outrun. LIL'S MARKET was through early on and stopped.
