DANDY'S LEGACY was bumped hard entering the first turn then settled on the turn down the backstretch, rallied three wide heading into the far turn and gained command then drew clear in upper stretch and was clearly best in the end. LAST CHIP was in tight entering the first turn and bumped with the winner then was settled on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn then was gaining ground in the stretch to be second best. ALMOST LEGENDARY was void of early speed then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be four wide in the stretch and made a mild gain in late stretch. ANOTHER RICA was inside on the backstretch then rallied two wide on the far turn making a bid but came up empty in the drive. DANZIGCA'S PICTURE was allowed to settle then raced three wide on the far turn then was no menace in the stretch. SUNRAY WAY dueled for the lead while two wide, was used up then gave way in the stretch drive. D'PARADI dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used then stopped on the far turn. IRISH DARCY was unhurried early then was no factor.
