PEANUT BUDDY chased the pace while racing three wide on the turn then was in a long drive and wore down MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION in deep stretch to prove best. RIZZI MONEY was inside heading into the turn then rallied and swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in the stretch but was too late. CANNONBALL EXPRESS was settled then rallied four wide on the turn and was gaining ground to finished well in late stretch. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION set the pace from the start, drew off on the turn then was in a long hard drive and tired in late stretch. PRIVATE PRESLEY raced five wide on the turn and made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat. NAKAYAMA KUN was pinched back at the start then made a made rally but was no factor. MCKAYSPECT broke out at the start and bumped then raced on the inside into the turn and faltered in the stretch. NIFTY ME broke in at the start and bumped then chased the pace while racing two wide, was used up and gave way in the drive. FRED'S DAY raced five wide on the turn and was no factor. HONORABLE LIFE was though early while four wide on the turn and stopped.
