### Footnotes

ANTIOCH DIAMOND was settled early on, rallied three wide in upper stretch then moved up to take command just past mid stretch and drew off in late stretch. BOOM BOOM BUBBA was unhurried early then swung out to be six wide in upper stretch then closed willingly to be along for the place. MR. CHIPS rallied on the turn then moved out to be five wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground in late stretch to finish well. PARKER RUN was unhurried early and racing three wide on the turn, made a mild gain in the stretch but was no menace in the end. K D KING chased the early pace while inside, was hard used then weakened in the stretch. LONE STAR BANDIT good early speed then drew off on the turn but weakened in the stretch drive. BUBBLE B. BUDDHA saved ground on the turn then faltered in the stretch. CELTIC SUNDAY was unhurried early then fanned out to be eight wide in upper stretch and was no factor. JOE MOVE chased the early pace while racing two wide on the turn, was used up and stopped in the stretch.
