NORMANDY SHORE was well placed while four wide on the run down the backstretch, moved up to vie for the lead while three wide on the turn then was in a long drive and drew off just past mid stretch then was all out to hold sway in the final strides. AINTTHATAKICKINTHE was well placed while racing two wide then dropped back before the turn, moved out to be three wide in upper stretch and rallied on the outside and was gaining ground but just missed in the final strides. KRISTYS BLUE pressed the early pace while three wide then vied for the lead while between rivals on the turn and stretch then weakened in late stretch. RED EYE FLIGHT was up closed early then dropped back entering the turn then raced three wide on the turn and made a mild rally in the stretch. SUSAN'S FANCY was shuffled back before the turn then rallied on the turn and swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in the stretch. THUNDERPANTS set the early pace while being pressured then vied for the lead on the turn was inside then was used up and gave way in the stretch. TEHIGH was on the inside on the turn and was no factor. TACKHIMUP was unhurried early and was no factor.
