UP FOR A RODEO stalked from the outside, raced three wide in the turn, easily moved at the leader, was shaken up at the quarter pole, in tight with rival down the stretch yet managed to win with the jockey keeping the whip tucked away. LATENT PROSPECT was encouraged to contest the early lead, disposed of a rail at the three-eighths pole, was two wide in the turn, in tight with rival during the final eighth, grudgingly gave way. KILIAN'S BLEND tracked the early leaders, had the rail on the trip through the turn, could not go with the top two. TUFF RUHL waited for a moment leaving the three-eighths pole and then was able to swing out and pass a tiring rival at the quarter pole, two wide, ran determinedly down the stretch but could not make up the ground and get a minor placing. YES HE IS BRAVE raced toward the back of the pack, quickened pace at the three-eighths pole but had little left. UNCLE GRINGO settled in midpack and was four wide in the turn before tiring. REDBIRD RATES RHEMA raced to the front and quickly dueled, had the rail and tired before reaching the quarter pole. FORD'S CAT was slow into stride and showed little.
