### Footnotes

COLTON COUNTDOWN two wide in the turn after dueling for the lead, was a driving winner. GORDO AT WAR broke a tad slowly at the start yet found stride promptly for a tracking trip along the rail, maintained and came under the whip nearing the eight pole but no match for the winner. EXPECTING MAGIC pursued the leafing pack from the outside, had a five-wide trip through the turn and determinedly pursued through the stretch. LUKE THE DUKE was bumped inward leaving the starting gate, traveled through the turn at least five wide and continued a long rally through the stretch. STEALIO pursued the leaders, asked to keep up with three-eighths to go, six wide in the turn, nothing left. JOSCO was three wide in the turn, veered outward turning for home and was tired. BO DEVIL was held in place by the assistant starter while the starting gate opened prematurely, waited for gate to be shut once again and remained near the back of the pack. COOL AND BRAVE stumbled leaving the start and showed little. WILD WEST MAN was asked to keep up from a midpack position at the half-mile pole, traveled three wide entering the turn, stopped. COOL FRENCH SAFARI unhurried early and remained at the back.
