Footnotes

I'M ONE KOOL DUDE dueled for the early lead while two wide in the opening turn, continued alongside a rival down the backstretch and traveled two off the rail still through the final turn, was driven to the wire with a steady right-handed whip and held on for the win. SAND DUSTY dueled for the early lead while two wide, continued with a rival down the backstretch and stayed alongside while having rail trip, finally lost touch with the leader after the quarter pole yet continued on determinedly for second place. GO FOR DOUGH traveled three wide in the first turn, four wide in the second bend and hung in that spot down the stretch. APRIL EXPECTATIONS was four wide in the first turn, slowly advanced down the backstretch, had a spot along the rail in the second turn, was shaken up at the three-sixteenths marker and commenced a sharp rally that nearly won out the show spot. NAFISS was three wide in the first turn, was restrained until the quarter pole while traveling along the rail yet had no rally down the lane. FIEND A BIT unhurried early, maintained a spot on the rail through the second turn and lacked a strong finish. HASHA was prompted early, two wide in the first turn, took the second turn six wide and tired. THREEDRINKMINIMUM had the rail early and soon tired. SPECIAL DURBEE was six wide and pulled the rider through the opening turn, was five wide in the second turn and tired. KIEARA WISH was seven wide in the first turn, challenged for a forward spot but tired. CARSONCITYGAMBLER had a rail trip and showed little.
