SPECIAL U F O quickly joined the leaders and had a rail trip through the turn, was allowed to quicken pace approaching the quarter pole, was shaken up at the top of the stretch, responded with a clear lead at the eighth pole and was kept in a drive while drawing off to the wire. HIDDEN TICKET dueled for the lead, was joined on the inside by SPECIAL U F O by the completion of the backstretch, took the turn two wide and gamely held on to second while being no match for the winner. MULA RUN settled in midpack, was two wide in the turn, dropped down to the rail for the final eighth of a mile and made a rally to almost nip second place. G'S PRAYER settled in midpack, took the turn four wide and had a belated rally. ENCODED raced near the back, was five wide in the turn and showed a mild rally. UNCLE PHIL'S HOPE posed no serious threat. PRIME REVIVAL stumbled leaving the gate, pursued the leaders from the outside and lacked a serious bid. IF I WIN THELOTTO was unhurried early and made no advance. MAMBO COUNCIL was bumped at the start, pressed the leading group, was asked nearing the half-mile pole, tired. ALFAJOR was always near the back. CHRIS'EXPECTATIONS dueled for the lead, had a rail trip and stopped. ON A BLACK CHARGER was bumped at the start, raced near the back of the pack. CAN'T SEE HOME broke inward and always trailed.
