GREAT HOPE was eager to chase after leaders then settled and raced four wide through the turn, began to draw away in the stretch until appearing to shy from the photo-finish light late. HONKYTONK STOMP was urged along after the start but could not get clear of an inside rival heading into the turn where caught three wide before grudgingly giving way to the winner. MALABAR SLEW was slow to get into stride and raced four wide through the turn before coming full of run with a late rally. MILE MARKER allowed to let the lead group advance and saved ground behind, got an inside trip through the turn but still raced in close behind the lead group, got room in the stretch but finished evenly. BAGGY CAT dueled for the lead through the turn, where eased out to two wide and faltered late. SWINGIN CAT was off slowly at the start and unhurried to make a move before a mild advance late. THUNDERPANTS attempted to go with the lead group after the start but soon fell back and six wide through the turn with little left for the stretch. SUPER STRUGGLER broke sharply but soon fell back and was five wide in the turn and did not rally. TASTE BIG was slow to start and never threatened.
