**Footnotes**

I'M ONE KOOL DUDE set an unpressured pace along the rail, was joined by a rival from the outside down the backstretch, raced three wide in the second turn, was roused before the stretch and had enough left to hold on for the win. MR. DUBAI tracked the early leader while two wide through the turn, joined that one down the backstretch but could not match strides while traveling four wide in the second turn, made a belated rally that fell short. BLUE HAZE settled shortly out of the gate and eased to the rail for the first turn, remained unhurried till the half mile, stalked while five wide in the second turn and joined the runnerup in making a belated rally. OKLAHOMA HERO broke awkwardly but was asked to pick it up, racing midpack by the backstretch, was eight wide in the second turn and failed to close. AY DIOS MIO had a six-wide trip through the first turn, tracked the leaders and lacked a rally. DRIVIN OR FLYIN seven wide on the second turn and was no threat. BUBBA KIP was three wide in the first turn and was kept behind the leaders but offered no rally. TAPPYHOUR was caught five wide in the first turn, raced midpack, faltered. ABICUS went into the first turn unhurried and nine wide and was no threat. EXPRESSO broke slowly and dropped behind the pack and was taken 10 wide by the rider on the first turn and figured as no threat.
