WALKWAY vied for the early lead while inside, was well handled and responded on the far turn to take command then was kept to strong pressure to hold sway in late stretch. RARE FLYER stalked the pace while racing two wide in the second flight then rallied on the far turn three wide and was gaining ground to finish well. BENGAL TRADER stalked the pace while racing three wide in the second flight then rallied five wide on the far turn making a strong bid to late stretch but hung in the end. MALABAR SLEW was unhurried early while racing three wide heading into the far turn then swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. LITTLE SCOUT stalked the pace while racing inside then made a bid on the far turn to mid stretch but came up empty in the drive. I'MBACK AND I'MBAD was angled inside leaving the chute and unhurried early, saved ground throughout and made a mild rally while inside in the stretch but was no threat. CACHEMASSA CREEK vied for the early lead while between rivals, was hard used and gave way in upper stretch. TYLER B vied for the early lead while three wide, was used up and gave way on the far turn. BURBERRY BULLET was settled then made a middle move while five wide on the far turn and stopped in the stretch.
