ROUNDUP JADE was settled in the early going then saved ground on the turn, rallied along the inside in the stretch and slipped through the inside in late stretch to be along in time. COOK'S NOOK was unhurried early then circled the field while racing nine wide at the top of the stretch, was gaining ground willingly but came up short in the end. TWO JAYS SECRET was settle in the early going then rallied eight wide on the turn, was in tight nearing the top of the stretch then was gaining ground in late stretch to finish full of run. SNOW CAP was settled early on then rallied on the turn while three wide, was in tight

quarters nearing the top of the stretch then split rivals and was gaining ground in late stretch. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION vied for the lead while inside on the turn, drew off in mid stretch but could not last in deep stretch. CALEB BOY was settled then rallied along the inside on the turn, saved ground then bore out in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. MAMBO AGAIN vied for the early lead while between rivals, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch. MITEYLIKEAROSE was unhurried early and stayed on the inside on the turn then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. HOW'S THAT was making a four wide middle move on the turn then was in tight nearing the top of the stretch and faltered in the drive. OUR COUNTRY was inside then hustled along and made a bid three wide on the turn, bore out in upper stretch and gave way in the drive. TATES MANDATE raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. Z STRIKE GOLD chased the early pace while racing on the turn then was shuffled back bearing the quarter pole then stopped in the stretch. FIERA DEL SOL vied for the lead while three wide, was used up then stopped in the stretch drive. SEATTLE SAL lunged at the start and somersaulted the rider off soon after the break. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the start. After reviewing the films, no action was action.
