LISA'S KITTEN was angled inside soon after the start to saved ground on the first turn, was inside on the run down the backstretch then was blocked at the half mile pole and forced to steadied sharply, recovered and rallied two wide on the far turn, angled inside in upper stretch and responded with a strong drive and gained command in late stretch then bobbed nearing the wire while trying to jump the finish line light. WINNING TALE was allowed to settled then raced on the inside on the first turn, rallied three wide on the far turn making a strong bid on the far turn, made a strong bid in upper stretch then was outfinished in late stretch. SEASONED was unhurried early while saving ground on the first turn, raced on the outside on the winner on the backstretch then rallied two wide heading into the far turn, moved out to be three wide in upper stretch making a strong bid and gained a narrow lead in upper stretch then hung in the end. SHOTGUN GULCH vied for the lead while four wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then was in a long drive but tired in late stretch. LEGENDARY DAY was allowed to settle in the early going, rallied three wide on the far turn then made a mild gain in the stretch drive. RULE OF TWELFTHS raced five wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch drive. C C'S PAL vied for the early lead while

three wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch drive. JOY'S PARADISE raced four wide on the backstretch then made a bid on the far turn while four wide then failed to menace in the stretch. NEW ELITE was three wide on the backstretch then was shuffled back heading into the far turn and was no threat in the stretch. GRAND OPRY vied for the lead while two wide, was hard used then gave way on the far turn. FARRAH'S ANGEL was five wide heading into the first turn then bore out in the middle of the turn, raced five wide on the backstretch then lacked a rally in the drive. CHANEL NUMBER NINE vied for the early lead from the inside, was used up and stopped nearing the half mild pole.
