COOK'S NOOK settled behind lead group, 3-wide in the turn, whip at 1/8th. WIMBLETON PRINCE asked to keep up early, swung 5-wide turn, steady gain. SEATTLE SAL settled midpack, 2-wide turn, no threat. QUIET DOMINATION dueled, led at 3/8, rail through turn, under whip, tired. BOTTOM TO TOP trailed early, 2-wide turn, mild rally. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION raced behind early leaders, 3-wide turn, tired. SPECIAL DURBEE started near back, 5-wide turn, no threat. FAN CLUB slow into stride, advanced slowly at 3/8ths pole, 6-wide turn, lost rider past the wire but was returned to be unsaddled. LOTS OF PURPOSE dueled for the lead, stopped leaving 3/8ths pole.
