LEGAL MIND was not far behind early, took the first turn five wide, came under restraint after the opening quarter mile, was two wide in the second turn, responded to urging at the eighth pole and drew off. SAPHIRE BREEZE sat behind the early lead along the rail, waited with three eighths left, was swung four wide in the second turn to find room, was on even terms with the leader entering the stretch but could not match strides with the winner. MEMORY allowed to go to the front, had a two-wide trip but was unable to mount a serious bid. ABBIES KRISTEN was three wide in the opening turn while pursuing the leaders, slowly advanced to go three wide in the second turn and passed tired horses in the stretch. ALL RED dropped in behind leaders, was three wide in the first turn, checked at the seven-sixteenths marker, swung five wide in the second turn and managed at long rally. JADE'S KITTY raced in tight quarters while three wide in the first turn, advanced at the three-eighths pole but was four wide upon reaching the quarter-mile marker and tired. LONDON BLUE was allowed to contest pace while four wide in the opening turn, continued to race along with the lead down the backstretch, challenged with three-eighths remaining, tired while two wide at the quarter pole. GLORIOUS DEVON eagerly went for the front but was three wide in that first turn, asked for run at the half-mile pole and began to drop back when reaching the three-eighths marker. NINETIES GRANDGIRL got pinched back at the start, made a four-wide bid at the quarter pole and did not threaten in the stretch. MISS JUMPIN JULEP broke inward from the start, was three wide in the opening turn and soon dropped back to trail.
