Footnotes

HARTFELT stalked the pace while racing on the inside down the backstretch, rallied two wide coming out of the far turn and was in a strong drive to prove best in the end. WASTED TEARS was allowed to settle then stalked the leaders while three wide down the backstretch, was blocked and steadied off heels in the middle of the far turn, swung out four wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch but was too late. TIMELY REFLECTION dueled for the lead from the inside then drew off coming out of the turn, was in a long drive and weakened in late stretch. NEW BLUE was two wide on the first turn then saved ground on the inside on the far turn, made a bid on the far turn in upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. SENTIMENTAL SONG was settled in the early going then started a run on the far turn, swung out seven wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground but was no threat in late stretch. MONARCHOS STAR was unhurried early then started a rally on the far turn while four wide on the far turn and made a mild gain in the stretch but was no threat. APALACHEE WAY was unhurried early and settled then raced three wide on the far turn, made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat. YOU KNOW WHO I AM pressed the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and gave way in the middle of the far turn. FLEETFUL CAT dueled for the early lead while two wide, was hard used and gave way in upper stretch. MISS MISSILE was carried out on the first turn then chased the

pace while racing five wide, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and faltered in the stretch. MIA AGGIE was unhurried early then was steadied off heels on the far turn and was no threat. CLASSIE BALOO bore out on the first turn then chased the pace while four wide on the backstretch, bore out on the far turn then stopped in the drive.
