FEBRUARY GOLD was under the whip shortly after leaving the gate, soon pushed along to advance from the back, challenged the two leaders heading into the turn, was three wide through the bend and kept to task to the wire. AT FULL PELT raced to the early lead but soon was challenged from the outside, two wide while under pressure in the turn, was under a right-handed whip in the stretch and grudgingly gave way. KNOCKIN AROUND was slow into stride and trailed, ranged up heading for the turn and was eight wide through the bend, drifted inward in the stretch, straightened course and continued to rally to the wire. UP FOR A RODEO was pushed along to chase the leaders at the three-eighths pole, raced four wide in the turn and was game to finish a close fourth. DIRTY DAVE was five wide in the turn and raced evenly to the finish. V L T OR BUST stumbled at the start, was seven wide in the turn and mounted no serious threat after that. CATCH MOUNTAIN trailed, was three wide in the turn while mounting a rally but did not reach contention. WOLFMANLEX challenged the leader from the outside, felt pressure from another pressure from the outside, dropped back entering the turn and tired. NO PRESSURE reached the turn two wide but tired.
