FLYER'S FANTASY was pushed along to chase the early lead, advanced steadily to lead leaving the turn while three wide and was a driving winner. BLUES IN THE GRASS came under a drive approaching the quarter pole while racing along the rail, continued inside and made a determined late bid. SPANISH FEVER was pushed along to chase the early lead, kept to the rail while still under a challenge through the turn, came under a left-handed whip leaving the eighth pole and drifted out, could not match strides. MONICA'S SKIRMISH was pushed to keep up early, had to go out six wide in the turn to keep on the pursuit and hung in the final eighth. PELO'S GIRL lunged at the start and was quickly several lengths behind, advance slowly and was six wide in the turn, continued with a long rally. I KNOW JOE raced out to duel with the early leader, soon settled back but stayed in pursuit, was four wide in the turn and failed to mount a serious threat. BELLAMY CLASS unhurried early, was under the whip while advancing five wide in the turn and had nothing left for the stretch. STORMIN MISSILE raced nine wide in the turn and still made a belated rally. ALY DON'T TOUCH raced to the early lead but was quickly pressured from the inside, departed the quarter pole three wide and under the whip, failed to keep up. MISS ARANZA showed early foot but soon sat behind the lead group, was under the whip at the five-sixteenths marker and had no response.
