Footnotes

TAKE A LITTLE NOTE was eight wide in the opening turn while under restraint, advanced nearing the second turn, was three wide in the turn while in a duel for the lead and drove on to the wire when HIDDEN TICKET lunged inward at the turf chute. HIDDEN TICKET was five wide and hard to handle in the first turn, advanced nearing the second turn and was two wide, dueled for the lead, lunged inward when arriving at the completion of the temporary rail of the turf chute, gathered back up by the rider at the sixteenth pole and ridden to keep second place safe. SPENDARIDGE dropped in behind the leaders and was two wide in the opening turn, joined the leader and engaged in a duel and drew off with that rival down the backstretch, had the rail in the final turn but did not advance in the stretch. ENCODED rated and was six wide in the opening turn, went four wide in the second turn and made a slow advance. MONK E SEE was content in midpack while three wide in the first turn, was hung four wide in the final turn and was no serious threat in the stretch. STORM PRIZE was four wide in the first turn while dueling for the lead, had the rail in the second turn but finished evenly. ONE MORE FLIGHT broke inward, was two wide in the first turn, no serious threat. CHRIS'EXPECTATIONS was forwardly placed but five wide in the opening turn, five wide in the second turn with no late bid. MOONLITE MAYHEM was 10-wide in the first turn then six wide in the second and was done. SOUTEX SONG was slow out of the starting gate, six wide in the first turn and always near the back. MAMBO COUNCIL dueled for the lead while three wide in the opening turn, engaged with that rival and drew off down the backstretch, soon tired. A claim of foul was made by the rider of CHRIS'EXPECTATIONS against the rider of ENCODED, but was not allowed by the stewards.
