NO LIL LIMIT was urged to go to the front, easily clear by the three-eighths pole, driving. WOLF BRANCH sent after the early leaders, five wide in the turn, held second. BACHELOR PAD was asked to keep up, two wide in the turn and grudgingly held third. WE ADORE THEODORE broke slowly, slowly advanced, was six wide in the turn and offered a mild rally. GRAVITY STORM chased the lead, was six wide in the turn and faded. BIG TONY settled in midpack, unhurried, two wide in the turn and no rally. SULTRY CROOK chased the lead, rail, soon tired. BECKY'PAYCZECH broke awkwardly, was asked to keep up, no threat. SEBASTION chased the lead, ridden for speed, four wide in the turn and no factor.
