PHARME LEGEND broke sharply, five wide in the first turn, settled, circled five wide in the final turn while in hand, roused nearing the eighth pole a drew off to win. WHY BILL WHY seven wide in the opening turn and content to race of the lead, the moved to the front leaving the first turn, was three wide in the second turn and could not match strides late. SPIDERMAN RIDGE was unhurried in the opening stages and dropped in for a rail trip, rallied. LUCKY RAJA contested for the lead three wide in the opening turn, three wide in second turn and faded. CATRIN eight wide in the opening turn and unhurried, four wide in the second turn and lacked a rally. ZAP A PRINCE was forwardly placed along the rail, came under a drive nearing the quarter pole but was finished. SUMKINDOFNOTHIN settled in midpack but raced evenly throughout. OLD CHUNK OF COAL chased the early lead three wide and soon lacking room in the first turn, checked after the opening quarter and soon tired. WIMBLEDON PRINCE was never in serious contention. IHEARUCALLINGME was six wide in the first turn and soon tired. IRISH QUICKSILVER always near the back. DIRTY PICTURE broke in the air, raced up toward the leaders, circled out and was four wide in the opening turn, tired before entering the stretch.
