SLAMMING broke sharply and soon found the lead, was challenged from both sides, was two wide in the turn with one horse to beat, was shaken up and given the whip with an eighth of a mile remaining, veered out somewhat but was kept busy in the drive to win at the wire. ISLAND ARTIST allowed to chase the leaders, soon was dueling for the top spot, had a trip close to the rail, kept in contact with SLAMMING down the stretch but drifted outward nearing the final sixteenth and was outfinished. BRAZZLE DAZZLE was slow into stride but soon allowed to advance, reached a contending spot in midpack with five-sixteenths remaining, went two wide in the turn and determinedly ran for third,. BULINDAMARIE duelled for the lead from the outside, dropped back from the lead pair at the three-eighths pole, was four wide in the turn and soon was passed by others. B G NEW IDEA settled in midpack, flagged along under the whip while six wide in the turn and had little left for the run home. AGGIE FRIEND was put under a drive to reach the pursuing group with three-eighths to go, took the turn seven wide and made no rally. I'M SPECIAL swerved at the start, had trouble keeping up and was outrun.
