ALOHA HANK stalked the pace while saving ground on the turn, rallied along the inside in the stretch and was in a strong drive to prove best in late stretch. INLINEFORPICTURES set a fast pace from the start, drew off on the turn then weakened in late stretch but held the place safe in the end. LONE STAR BANDIT rallied three wide on the turn making a strong bid to mid stretch but came up empty in the drive. WILLIAMSBURG SLEW chased the pace while racing two wide, raced evenly and failed to menace in the stretch. EXCLUSIVE NIGHT was unhurried early then made a late gain while four wide in the stretch and was no threat. MELBAS SLEW raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. SAUCEY TERMINATOR was on the inside on the turn and was no threat. THOMAS VAN raced four wide on the turn and was outrun. SHERRYS CAT trailed throughout.
