STORMY DONNA GAIL bid for the early lead, was given mild encouragement approaching the quarter pole, kept the rail through the turn, shaken up nearing the three-sixteenth marker, tapped with the stick at the eighth pole but soon put in a hand ride for a driving win. WESTERN WONDER was content to be at the back of the pack early, saved ground and had rail while on the move in the turn, maintained a long rally and just missed the win. NIGHT LADY allowed to duel for the lead, two wide in the turn, was kept busy down the stretch but hung in the final yards. I KNOW JOE was asked to keep up while running in midpack, three wide in the turn, rallied but made no impact down the stretch. ART DESIGN raced for a leading spot, caught three wide in the turn and tired. IDE BET DIXIE raced along while at the back of the pack, had a four-wide trip through the turn. MISS ARANZA was pushed along for the lead, was four wide in the turn and stopped. JETTIN WAGON was well back shortly after the start and was always near the back. SOSIDY broke in a tangle, rider lost the irons and trailed throughout. The stewards conducted an inquiry following the running of the race concerning the start for SOSIDY and ruled the race's final results to be official.
