Footnotes

WILD SAILOR GIRL raced off the pacesetters from between rivals, dropped back nearing the three-eighths pole, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with a late surge to be up in the final yards. BIDDY LULU lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, angled inside between rivals nearing the sixteenth marker, gained a brief lead but could not resist the winner. B G COUNTRY GIRL set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged by KIPLING'S RED BIRD with three furlongs to run, came back to take command into the lane and gave way grudgingly late. B G QUEEN LEGACY chased the leaders from the outside throughout and gave way gradually in the drive. KIPLING'S RED BIRD pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way after going seven furlongs. COUSHATA LADY was never far back while racing from off the rail, appeared hard to rate through the backstretch and lacked the needed closing response. SURPRIZED WINNER was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to rally. WITT'S ATTITUDE lacked early foot, dropped far back after going six furlongs and was eased through the lane.
