QUIET ACCELERATION settled in midpack and was four wide in the clubhouse turn, rated down the backstretch and came within range of the lead while still traveling easily past the half mile, contested the lead through the turn and was four wide, was roused approaching the quarter pole, drew clear and won driving. SWASS LIKE ME raced up to contest the early lead along the rail in the first turn, drifted out and was two wide in the second turn while still under a challenge, dueled on past the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. RICH MONARCHOS settled back in midpack while along the rail, kept the rail through the final turn and made a rally. STREET LIFE BLUES was allowed to contest the early lead while two wide in the opening turn, stayed beside the leader down the backstretch and was three wide in the final turn between horses on the front, fought on until the eighth pole and finally was overmatched and drifted out in the final yards. ORIENT DANCER settled back and was four wide in the first turn, stalked, failed to join others in pursuit of the lead while three wide in the second turn before tiring. KNOCKIN AROUND broke outward and took the first turn two wide, quickly raced up and traveled five wide in the second turn and failed to make a serious rally. SHOMEWHATUWORKNWI broke slowly and failed to threaten. AVEC GLASS stalked the early lead three wide, maintained that position in the second turn but was retreating before the quarter pole. MEANT TO BE HERE hurried and was five wide in the opening turn then three wide entering the backstretch and had enough.
