Footnotes

ONLY MAN IN TOWN was allowed to ease in behind the early leaders finding a spot by the rail in the opening turn, challenge the lead and went three wide on the second turn and was a driving winner. HOLLY JET was unhurried to take a spot in midpack along the rail in the opening turn, was two wide in the second turn, angled out in the stretch and finished a long advance by getting the place in the final yards. MAJESTIC TREE raced up to a lead position and a spot along the rail in the first turn, gave up the lead and rallied back but swung out to be three wide, lacked room at the three-eighths pole, came under the whip approaching the quarter pole and finished evenly. CASHINMYWRANGLERS raced up to a lead position contesting a rival from two wide in the opening turn, drew clear down the backstretch and raced along the rail to the stretch and finished evenly. ROAD WORK settled and was four wide in the opening turn but never mounted a serious challenge. MACEDONIAN broke slowly, rail, never in serious contention. TAKSENT was unhurried along the rail in the clubhouse turn raced along in midpack but failed to rally. DOMENICK'S DUNE was content to settle in midpack while two wide in the opening turn, was three wide in the final turn and did not threaten. CLUB TEJANO stalked three wide in the first turn, was two wide in the final turn and faded. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP fell back in midpack and swung out five wide in the first turn and soon faltered. LIL'S MARKET chased after the leaders but drifted four wide in the first turn and was never in contention. WALKWAY went in pursuit of the leaders but was four wide in the first turn and quickly tired.
