TATNALL STREET settled two wide in the opening turn, stalked, was five wide in the second turn, roused at the top of the stretch and was a driving winner. QUE DESEO saved ground in the opening turn settled in midpack, was two wide in the opening turn and maintained that position, gamely on. GREAT HOPE was rated to take a spot in behind the leaders two wide in the first turn but soon swung out four wide before leaving the turn, maintained that position through the second turn and battled. SAFE RANGE veered inward but saved ground with a rail rip in the opening turn, was four wide in the second turn and finished with a strong rally. MR. ROAD WARRIOR taken back and was three wide in the first turn, maintained that position in the final turn but failed to threaten. HEAVY AS METAL was off slowly, made a five wide rally in the second turn. I AM TARZAN was sent to challenge the lead between horses and two wide in the opening turn, three wide in the second turn and tired. EMPTY PAGES raced in a forward position to get two wide in the first turn and faded. BIG SCRAPE was sent to challenge the lead, three wide in the first turn, two wide in the final turn before fading. JAKEONTHERUN chased behind the leaders and swung out three wide in the opening turn, two wide in the second turn and failed to rally. PRACTICE TEE restrained and unhurried three wide in the first turn but never threatened. CAT FROM ROME was sent to the front along the rail in the first turn, eased out to be two wide and tired in the final turn.
