WASPY CEE settled, circled six wide in the turn, driving finish. FIREBALL'S ACE dueled, rail trip through turn, clear top of stretch, outfinished. JALOPE JOE broke in, chased for the lead, rail trip, finished evenly. SEMICONDUCTOR pursued leaders, three wide in the turn, finished evenly. LUCKY RAJA pursued the leaders, three wide in the turn, no threat. THE TAP dropped back at the start, three wide in the turn before making a mild advance. IRISH DARCY settled, rail trip, no threat. DADDY BEN broke slowly and soon was near the back. SIR JAIME broke in the air and bumped at the start, never reached contention. MALABAR SLEW dueled, two wide in the turn, faltered. LITTLE ONION settled, five-wide advance, no threat. MAD MONEY was prompted for an attempt at the lead, soon tired.
