### Footnotes

ROAD WORK was unhurried early and settled on the run down the backstretch, moved up the inside on the far turn then rallied two wide in upper stretch, gained command in upper stretch and drew off in the end. MR. CHIPS was well placed while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a strong bid on the far turn and was in a long drive but was no match for the winner in late stretch while being second best. CATRIN was allowed to settle in the early going then rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid but came up empty in the stretch drive. UNFORSEEN TERMS was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while inside, was gaining ground in late stretch but was no menace. MAKE IT REAL was bumped hard at the start then settled on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch drive. CELTIC SUNDAY was bumped at the start then set the early pace, was used up then gave way in the stretch. CRYPTISH was bumped hard at the start then settled, rallied along the inside on the far turn making a bid then faltered in the stretch drive. HERE COMES BADNESS was unhurried early and failed to menace. CITY ACADEMY was allowed to settle on the inside, saved ground then faltered. COLD DAWN was pinched back at the start then was no factor. LIGHTEN UP BUZZ pressed the early pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, was used up and stopped on the far turn.
