BROADWAY MISSILE broke inward and was eager in front of the grandstand but reined in for a stalking position inside, was two wide in the final turn, roused, kept to task and hung on. PERKY KITTEN lunged at the break and trailed, advanced three wide while under the whip at the quarter pole, was hard ridden in the stretch, veered out, drifted in and just missed. RAINBOW TRIP settled, two wide in the final turn, found room along the rail with about an eighth of a mile remaining and finished with a rally that just missed. F J UNCLE VIC settled and was three wide in the opening turn, placed in a tight hold departing the three-quarter pole, was allowed to make chase down the backstretch, mounted a three-wide challenge at the three-eighths marker, drifted in with an eighth of a mile left and gamely carried on to the wire. MARGARITA BIBB was allowed to run to the front but was two wide in the opening turn, had the rail in the final turn yet hung in the stretch. PONTOTOC stalked inside, was two wide in the final turn and followed horses to the wire. WITT'S FIVE was eager to press the pace on the inside, had the rail in the second turn but was tired.
