Footnotes

VALIDATED BLARNEY was sent to the lead, pressured heading into the turn and past the quarter pole while racing along the rail, edged clear while under urging leaving the eighth pole and responded under a driving finish. ABBIE KATES WAY was encouraged to go after the early lead, was in a duel between horses for the top spot past the quarter pole while two wide, outfinished from the eighth pole to the wire. L X GAMBLER not among the lead group early, settled, started a slow advance nearing the three-eighths pole, raced four wide while on the move in the turn, angled out past the sixteenth marker and rallied for third. LAZER RED was sent to chase the early lead, kept the pressure on while racing three wide past the quarter pole yet hung in the stretch. MULA GOLD was allowed to press the pace, was asked to keep up approaching the quarter pole while two wide and raced evenly through the stretch. THREE LEG EXPRESS was in a chase for the leading group until the five-sixteenth marker, checked, was shaken up past the quarter pole and three wide yet could not draw into contention. CRAFTY FORTUNE reared a bit at the start and was bumped, had a rail trip but had no response to the whip in the turn.
