TUNED CRUSADER was allowed to go up for the lead, was given some mild encouragement approaching the quarter pole while benefiting from a rail trip, got a few cracks from the whip entering the stretch, responded and was kept under a drive for the win. SHEZAFAST MAGNACAT soon joined the lead group with a quick move along the rail, was under the whip at the quarter pole while easing out two wide, was urged before the eighth pole but outclassed by the winner. PEAKABOO BRIDE was pushed along by the rider to track the leaders, passed horses at the quarter pole and was three wide, drifted out slight at the eighth pole and finished evenly. CHRIS'EXPECTATIONS was encouraged to vie for the top spot, was shaken up while four wide at the quarter pole, veered out and bobbed inward before reaching the eighth pole and was no threat late. AUTUMN TRAIN stalked while in midpack, was under a drive leaving the three-eighths pole, raced along the rail in the turn but had little left for the finish. KOTARO FUMA was content to let others race at the leaders, advanced while under urging leaving the half-mile pole, was under a right-handed whip at the quarter pole while four wide and was no threat to the leaders in the stretch. RUFF SLEW was very slow at the start and veered outward and remained at the back of the pack. PARTY FEST was urged for speed early but was tired leaving the three-eighths pole.
