EXPECTING MAGIC let others pursued the pace, was given some mild encouragement leaving the three-eighths pole and responded, was shaken up at the quarter pole during a six-wide run through the turn, came under the whip at the top of the stretch and edged away for the win. HAVEN'S A CALLING lunged inward at the start and bumped slightly but was asked to chase the early lead, contended and was three wide in the turn, asked for more while passed at the at the eighth pole and grudgingly gave way. BROOKS OPEN GOLD was content to race along midpack in the run up to the turn, six wide in the turn and barged through to find room at the top of the stretch and made a late rally. BO THE DUKE veered outward at the start, soon set out for the leaders and joined the lead group on the outside without prompting from the rider, drifted out further to be four wide a the quarter pole and tired. WAITINGTOBEKING was asked to pursue the leader early, had a rail trip through the turn and tired. STORMIN' TREVOR was asked to keep up while toward the back of the pack early, came under the whip leaving the three-eighths pole, was on the rail in the turn and had no rally. PICABOO TAG stumbled badly out of the gate, was two wide in the turn and under constant urging but was no factor. WILD WEST MAN was promoted to go after the early pacesetters, pushed out seven wide leaving the quarter pole and lacked a response. SWORD CAT was hustled to the front, came between rivals heading into the turn, drifted out five wide in the turn and stopped.
