Footnotes

GONE FOR HOME stalked the early lead and was three wide in the opening turn, was four wide in the final turn while under a drive, kept to task to the wire and wore down the leader. ROY LAKE was quickly out of the gate and easily went to the lead, two wide in the first turn, raced on while the jockey tried to apply some restraint, was three wide in the second turn, was clear while under constant urging until the sixteenth marker and could not hold on. DEAD CAT BOUNCE settled in midpack and was three wide in the first turn, maintained that spot through the second turn and was a clear third. SAL'S BIG EASY was prompted to press the pace and was two wide in the first turn, maintained that position through the second turn and held fourth. MIDTOWN GROOM laid back well off the lead and was four wide in the first turn, maintained that position through the final turn and was even-paced through the stretch. KIEARA WISH was content to let others chase the pace and was four wide in the first turn, three wide in the second turn and made a mild rally. NOBIZLIKEHORSEBIZ was unable to get a prominent spot and took the clubhouse turn six wide and made little impact after that. DEPUTY WHY pressed the pace and was four wide at the first bend and soon tired. WHALEOFARIDE was shaken up early to press the pace and had a rail trip in the first turn and was no threat. DOITFORJOHNNY was unhurried and had to take the opening turn five wide and tired. KOOL SOLDIER broke outward and was bumped coming out of the gate and stayed close to the back. ENDLESS GOSSIP settled and had the rail in the first turn and showed little the rest of the way.
