SPANISH FEVER raced up for the lead, had a rail trip in the turn, under the whip at the three-sixteenth marker, driving. BLUES IN THE GRASS settled in midpack, had a two wide trip through the turn, rallied and prevailed for second. MISS GOSSIP challenged the early lead, was two wide in the turn with the leader directly in sight, veered past the sixteenth marker, outfinished for second. MAGICAL APPEAL stalked the pace, had the rail in the turn, made a mild rally. PELO'S GIRL pursued the leaders, three wide in the turn, no bid. SNOW RIDGE BLISS settled in midpack, under the whip at the quarter pole, four to five wide in the turn, faltered. MONICA'S SKIRMISH unhurried early and always near the back. YVONS GOLD was slow to start and always near the back. MSDIAMONDCITY was asked to keep pace behind the leaders, could not keep up.
