MISS KARBBER was urged along to keep up, swung four wide at the quarter pole, drew clear and veered outside and continued to drift while winning with a clear margin. FOOLISH VALIDATION was slow to start and pinched between horses, slowly advanced and had a six-wide trip through the turn, dug in and determinedly ran on for second. SWAMP LAST CHANCE settled, rushed up backstretch, four wide in the turn, outfinished for second. L. J. KATT broke inward and was steadied coming out of the starting gate, ridden along mid pack, had a rail trip and got through to loom as a threat at the top of the stretch but faltered. WAR LASS bumped slightly at the start, prompted for speed, was four wide in the turn and swung out at the top of the stretch but failed to rally. BRIGHTERTHANSUN stalked the front, was three wide in the turn and tired in the stretch. TAKE IT AND FLY dueled, was two wide in the turn and was no menace in the stretch. B G BLUE STAR chased, was four wide in the turn and tired. ONCE A WAVE settled mid pack but soon retreated.
