MIRACLE ON HIGH went to the lead and was quickly pressured, two wide through the turn, came under the whip to inside the sixteenth marker but won while being wrapped up in the final few yards. RACHEL'S SPECIAL settled but came under hand-urging past the three-eighths pole, three wide in the turn, rallied down the stretch but ran out of ground to settle for second. SIX SECTION lost footing at the start, quickly got into stride and was allowed to contest the lead, three wide in the turn, raced evenly in the stretch. DYNAMITE DOLL stalked and easily moved along in striking distance down the backstretch, two wide in the turn, advanced, rallied too late. ABBY'S MIRACLE was asked to keep up moving past the half-mile pole, had a rail trip but was no threat. Z LIL'S AUTUMN found a spot in midpack but soon was content to let others move at the leaders down the backstretch, came under the whip past the three-eighth pole, three wide in the turn but never threatened. MYMICHELLEGO was four wide in the turn and mounted no bid. MISS VICKI MCCABE broke to the outside and was slow to get started, progressed down the backstretch and was not too distant of the lead group, continued to move without much urging past the three-eighths pole but lacked a rally.
