Footnotes

POSITUTELY was allowed to run to the front but was pressured in short order, drifted a tad leaving the turn after a two-wide trip, challenged and almost on even terms with rivals on both sides with an eighth of a mile to go, responded to a right-handed whip and won in a drive. MARTYS WIMBLETON was asked to keep up in midpack, smartly placed by angling to the inside for a rail trip in the turn, was close to even terms with an eighth of a mile left but was outfinished. TRICKY RED DEVIL quickly dueled with the early leader, kept the pressure on while three wide in the turn, briefly pushed on from an inside rival leaving the turn, close to even terms for the lead nearing the eighth pole but hung through the stretch. RYALS easily found a stalking position down the backstretch, rail trip through the turn, no rally. GIMMEASPIN had trouble keeping up down the backstretch, three wide in the turn, no late bid. NIFTY NICKLE was urged along but remained toward the back, rail trip in the turn and never threatened. ESPECTACULAR QUEST unhurried early, two wide, failed to mount a rally. ABBIE KATES WAY was immediately asked to keep up with the lead leading pair, dropped back and was three wide in the turn while tiring. DANCE WITH DANNY was pushed along to keep within striking distance of the leaders but soon tired.
